

## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

Notice is hereby given that the Crook County Court will hold a public hearing on Wednesday, July 5, 2017, at 2 p.m. The hearing will be held in the Crook County Meeting Room at 320 NE Court Street, Prineville, OR 97754.

This hearing concerns a post-acknowledgment plan and land use regulation amendment. In January 2013, Central Oregon LandWatch, Oregon Dept. of Fish and Wildlife, and Oregon Dept. of Land Conservation and Development appealed those amendments to the Oregon Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA). On April 3, 2017, Crook County filed a motion with LUBA seeking voluntary remand so that it could reconsider its decision in light of the arguments presented on appeal. LUBA treated the County's motion for voluntary remand as a notice of withdrawal, and further ordered that a decision on reconsideration be filed with LUBA within 90 days of April 26, 2017 (on or before July 25, 2017).

The hearing is being held pursuant to OAR 661-010-0021. The hearing before the County Court shall be limited to County staff and petitioners to the pending LUBA appeal. The hearing on reconsideration shall provide an opportunity for the County Court to affirm, modify, or reverse its decision.

All documents and evidence in the record are available for inspection at no cost, and copies will be provided upon request subject to cost as set forth in the County's current fee schedule.

Persons or parties with standing in this subject matter may appear in person before the Crook County Court at the appointed time, or may submit written testimony to the County Court by 5 p.m. on Wednesday, June 28, 2017, addressed to: Jeff M. Wilson, Crook County Counsel, 300 NE Third St., Room 10, Prineville, OR 97754. Copies of the complete staff report to the County Court will be available for public review at least 7 days prior to the public hearing at the Crook County Legal Dept. at 203 NE Court St., Prineville, OR 97754.
