The Crook County Transportation System Plan (TSP) Update is a 20-year plan to guide the County's future transportation system.

Crook County is updating the existing TSP to address ongoing and anticipated transportation issues throughout the County.

The County, in partnership with ODOT and the community, will update the TSP with an emphasis on improving connections and safety conditions for all travelers - including those who drive, walk, bicycle, use a wheelchair or cane, or deliver freight.

In particular, the TSP Update will address:

- · County-wide transportation safety
- Planning and safely accommodating new growth
- Access and safety in the Powell Butte and Juniper Canyon areas
