Appearances / Item #7: Bobbi Aldridge, Secretary for the Oregon High School Rodeo Association appeared before the Court with High School Rodeo athletes: Ruby Snider, Adriene Steffen and Brooke Blevins to request a waiver for the Fairgrounds fees April 29<sup>th</sup> through May 1<sup>st</sup> for the Tri-County Rodeo and June 6<sup>th</sup> through 9<sup>th</sup> for the State Finals Rodeo. The County Court has waived the fees for these events before and are happy to do so this year.

Discussion item #8: County Counsel Eric Blaine discussed the two bids received from Kirby Nagelhout and Griffin Construction for the Belknap Exhibit Center. Both companies scored extremely well however, Kirby Nagelhout received the highest scoring bid.
