AMENDMENT NO. 3 TO LEASE AGREEMENT Staging Area (7-acres)

This Amendment No. 3 to Lease Agreement for a temporary Staging Area ("Amendment No. 3") is entered into this 20th day of 12022, by and between Crook County, a political subdivision of the State of Oregon ("County"), and Taylor Northwest LLC, an Oregon limited liability company ("Taylor NW"), collectively, "the Parties."

RECITALS

- A. WHEREAS, County and Taylor NW are parties to that certain Staging Area Lease Agreement dated May 29, 2020, for approximately 7-acres of real property informally known by the Parties as "the Northwest property;" and
- **B.** WHEREAS, the lease permits Taylor NW as tenant to extend the duration for four (4) one-year extensions. The first one-year extension is memorialized as Amendment No. 2; and
- **C. WHEREAS**, the Parties wish to memorialize the second one-year extension by the execution of this Amendment No. 3.

AGREEMENT

NOW, THEREFORE, in exchange for the mutual covenants contained below, Taylor NW and County agree as follows:

<u>Section One</u>: The Recitals listed above are incorporated herein by reference, as terms of contract and not mere recitals.

<u>Section Two</u>: The duration of the Staging Area Lease Agreement for the Northwest property is extended to May 29, 2023, unless sooner terminated according to its terms.

Section Three: Except as amended by this Amendment No. 3, all other terms of the Agreement as previously amended by Amendment No. 1 and Amendment No. 2 remain in full force and effect.

Section Four: This Amendment No. 3 may be executed in one or more counterparts, including electronically transmitted counterparts, which when taken

together shall constitute one in the same instrument. Facsimiles and electronic transmittals of the signed document shall be binding as though they were an original of such signed document.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, Taylor NW and County have executed this Amendment No. 3 effective May 29, 2022.

AMENDMENT NO. 8 TO PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT (Crook County GIS Contract)

This Amendment No. 8 is entered into by and between the City of Prineville, hereinafter referred to as "City," and Crook County, hereinafter referred to as "County."

RECITALS

WHEREAS, City and County are parties to that certain Professional Services Agreement (hereinafter "the Agreement") effective July 1, 2014, for the provision of GIS services to City; and

WHEREAS, beginning May 7, 2015, and each successive year thereafter, the parties have entered into Amendments 1 through 7 of the Agreement to extend the services for an additional year and periodically adjust the compensation; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement terminates at 11:59 p.m. on June 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to extend the duration of the Agreement for an additional year; and

WHEREAS, the parties agree to a three percent (3%) increase *plus* an additional \$5,000 for the next fiscal year (July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023).

AGREEMENT

NOW, THEREFORE, in exchange for the mutual covenants contained below, City and County agree as follows:

- 1. The recitals listed above are incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. Paragraph number 1 of the Agreement entitled "Effective Date and Duration" is modified to read as follows:

Effective Date and Duration: This Agreement is effective July 1, 2014. This Agreement terminates at 11:59 p.m. on June 30, **2023**. The Agreement will be evaluated and may be renewed by mutual consent.

3. Paragraph 2 of the Agreement entitled "Contractor's Services" is modified to read as follows:

"For the fiscal year 2022-2023, the total amount due for the services under this Agreement is \$33,584.55." (\$27,751.99 (FY 21-22) + \$832.56 (3%) + \$5,000)

4. This Amendment may be executed in one or more counterparts, including electronically transmitted counterparts, which when taken together shall constitute one in

the same instrument. Facsimiles and electronic transmittals of the signed document shall be binding as though they were an original of such signed document.

5. Except as amended by this Amendment No. 8, all other terms of the Agreement and any previous amendments remain in full force and effect.

The signing of this Contract (Agreement) by **CONTRACTOR** name above and Crook County, a political subdivision of the State of Oregon (**COUNTY**), authorizes **CONTRACTOR** to deliver the goods described below in consideration of the mutual covenants set forth herein.

- 1) PROJECT: The goods described below are to be provided by **CONTRACTOR** in connection with a Project identified as follows: <u>Crook County Chip Seal Oil Project Purchase & Application.</u>
- 2) DURATION: This Agreement shall run from date of execution through <u>September 1, 2022</u>, unless terminated or extended according to the provisions of this Agreement.
- 3) SCOPE OF SERVICES: **CONTRACTOR** shall supply the following for purchase: <u>Estimated</u> 770 tons of HFRS-P2/HFE-100S Chip Seal Oil. CONTRACTOR shall supply the following services: <u>Equipment and Operator for Application of Chip Seal Oil for each District</u>. See Also, paragraph 6 below.
- 4) FEE FOR SERVICES: **CONTRACTOR**'s fee for the goods and services identified in paragraph 3 shall be: \$494,725.00.
- 5) EXTRA SERVICES: **CONTRACTOR** may also perform Extra Services (services not specified under Scope of Services), provided **CONTRACTOR** and **COUNTY** have agreed in advance and in writing to the scope and fees for such Extra Services.
- 6) ATTACHMENTS: The original Invitation to Bid, Bidder's Proposal, and Specifications and Details are all incorporated herein and by reference made a part hereof.

STANDARD PROVISIONS

- 7) SUBMITTAL OF W-9 BEFORE PAYMENT: **CONTRACTOR** must provide **COUNTY** with a fully completed W-9 form upon execution of the Agreement and prior to supplying the goods. **CONTRACTOR** will not be paid until a fully completed W-9 form is submitted.
- 8) INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR: It is understood and agreed that **CONTRACTOR**, while supplying goods pursuant to this Agreement, is at all times acting and performing as an independent **CONTRACTOR**.
- 9) TAX DUTIES AND LIABILITIES: Neither federal, nor state, nor local income tax or payroll tax of any kind will be withheld or paid by **COUNTY**. **CONTRACTOR** is responsible to pay, according to law, **CONTRACTOR**'s income tax and self-employment tax, if applicable.
- 10) CONFIDENTIALITY: During the course of supplying of goods under this Agreement, **CONTRACTOR** may receive information regarding organizations and **COUNTY**'s business

- practices, employees, clients, etc. **CONTRACTOR** agrees to maintain the confidentiality of such information and to safeguard such information against loss, theft or other inadvertent disclosure.
- 11) AUTHORIZED SIGNATURES REQUIRED: Only those persons authorized by the Crook County Purchasing Rules and Procedures may enter into a binding agreement or contract, including a purchase order, for the purchase or sale of goods or services on the part of the County. All persons doing business with the County shall be responsible for being familiar with the Crook County Purchasing Rules and Procedures and for ensuring that the person purporting to act for the County has been duly authorized.
- 12) PAYMENT BY COUNTY: COUNTY will pay invoices on the 10th or 25th days of the month based upon date the invoice is received.
- 13) INDEMNIFICATION: **CONTRACTOR** shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless **COUNTY**, its agents, servants and employees, respectively, against all claims, demands and judgments (including attorney fees) made or recovered against them for damages to real or personal property or for bodily injury or death to any person, arising out of, or in connection with this Agreement, to the extent such damage, injury or death, is caused by the negligence or intentional wrongful act of **CONTRACTOR**, its employees, servants or agents.
- 14) COMPLIANCE WITH THE LAWS: **CONTRACTOR** agrees to comply with the provisions of this Agreement, Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, and with all applicable federal, state, county, and local statutes and rules.
- 15) PROTECTION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION: If **CONTRACTOR** obtains any personal information as defined in ORS 646A.602(11) related to this Agreement or concerning any County employee, **CONTRACTOR** agrees to provide appropriate safeguards to protect the security of this information. **CONTRACTOR** shall have provided appropriate safeguards by meeting or exceeding the requirements stated in ORS 646A.622.
- 16) CONDITIONS CONCERNING PAYMENT, CONTRIBUTIONS, LIENS, WITHHOLDING: Pursuant to ORS 279B.220, **CONTRACTOR** shall:
 - (a) Make payment promptly, as due, to all persons supplying to the **CONTRACTOR** labor or material for the performance of the work provided for in the Agreement;
 - (b) Pay all contributions or amounts due the Industrial Accident Fund from the **CONTRACTOR** or subcontractor incurred in the performance of the Agreement;
 - (c) Not permit any lien or claim to be filed or prosecuted against the state or a county, school district, municipality, municipal corporation, or subdivision thereof, on account of any labor or material furnished; and
 - (d) Pay to the Department of Revenue all sums withheld from employees under ORS 316.167.
- 17) CONDITIONS CONCERNING PAYMENT FOR MEDICAL CARE AND PROVIDING WORKERS' COMPENSATION: Pursuant to ORS 279B.230, CONTRACTOR shall:

- (a) Promptly, as due, make payment to any person, co-partnership, association, or corporation furnishing medical, surgical, and hospital care services or other needed care and attention, incident to sickness or injury, to the employees of **Contractor**, of all sums that **Contractor** agrees to pay for the services and all monies and sums that **Contractor** collected or deducted from the wages of employees under any law, contract, or agreement for the purpose of providing or paying for the services; and
- (b) Comply with ORS 656.017 or if not exempt under ORS 656.126.
- 18) ENTIRE AGREEMENT: This Agreement signed by both parties is the final and entire agreement and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous oral or written communications between the parties, their agents, and representatives.
- 19) AMENDMENTS: This Agreement may be supplemented, amended, or revised only in writing signed by both parties.

- 22) EQUIPMENT, TOOLS, MATERIALS, AND/OR SUPPLIES: **CONTRACTOR** will provide all equipment, tools, materials or supplies necessary to fulfill **CONTRACTOR**'s obligations under the terms of this agreement.

23) TERMINATION:

- (a) With reasonable cause, either party may terminate this Agreement effective immediately after giving written notice of termination for cause. Reasonable cause shall include material violation of this Agreement or any act exposing the other party to liability to others for personal injury or property damage;

- 24) NO AUTHORITY TO BIND CROOK COUNTY: **CONTRACTOR** has no authority to enter into contracts on behalf of **COUNTY**. This Agreement does not create a partnership between the parties.

COUNTY's failure to request, review, or comment on any such certificate(s) does not affect **COUNTY**'s rights or **CONTRACTOR**'s obligations hereunder.

- 29) ATTORNEY FEES: In the event an action, lawsuit, or proceeding, including appeal therefrom, is brought for failure to observe any of the terms of this Agreement, each party shall bear its own attorney fees, expenses, costs, and disbursements for said action, lawsuit, proceeding, or appeal.
- 30) WAIVER: The failure of either party at any time or from time to time to enforce any of the terms of this Agreement shall not be construed to be a waiver of such term or of such party's right to thereafter enforce each and every provision of the Agreement.

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31) COUNTERPARTS: This Goods and Services Contract may be executed in one or more counterparts, including electronically transmitted counterparts, which when taken together shall constitute one in the same instrument. Facsimiles and electronic transmittals of the signed document shall be binding as though they were an original of such signed document.

At a prior County Court work session, the GIS and Assessor's office presented material regarding the potential benefits of engaging a firm to provide oblique aerial imagery of real property parcels in Crook County. The expected cost for these services exceeded the threshold created by ORS 279B.070. The County investigated whether there was a statewide cooperative procurement agreement which could provide for the desired services, and found that Pictometry International Corp. had executed such an agreement.

Under ORS 279A.200 *et seq.*, if a contract executed by a qualifying Oregon public entity meets certain requirements, then other public entities are able to purchase under that contract on the same terms and conditions. The State has created the "OregonBuys" website, as successor to the earlier ORPIN website, as a clearinghouse for such agreements. Under Master Service Agreement # 7539, its exhibits, and its amendments, authorized users such as Crook County can directly purchase Pictometry services and products.

The attached order form incorporates the provisions of that Master Service Agreement and related documents, and describes the services and quantities to be ordered by Crook County. A number of items are listed at a discounted rate, including for some items a discount of 100%.

- a) Signatures of not less than 75 percent of the residents (one signature per dwelling) along the road, plus, in the event a resident is not the legal or equitable title holder, the signature of the last owner of record according to the county assessor's office.
- b) The name, phone number, (and email) of the designated contact person.
- c) The location of the road by description and map.
- d) The legal status of the road, if known.
- e) The existing road name, if known.
- f) The proposed road name. (A unique road name is recommended. *See Note on page 5)
- g) The reason for the request.
- h) Written response from the local post office.
- i) Written response from the county 911 dispatch manager.

This petition must also be accompanied by the applicable fee:

*This fee is non-refundable, non-transferable, and applies to the road name requested in this petition/application only. A unique road name is recommended. *See Note on page 5 Should the road name request be denied by County Court during the hearing process, a new petition/ application and applicable fee would be required to submit a different name.

PROCESSING THE APPLICATION

Once your application is deemed complete, the Addressing Division will begin processing your application. A hearing date will be set with the County Court and notice of the request will be sent to all residents abutting the road to determine the general consensus concerning the proposed road name. All affected agencies and departments will also be notified of the request. A recommendation and proposed order will be prepared for the County Court.

The County Court will conduct a public hearing on the recommendation and order at a regular court meeting. Following the public hearing, the court shall adopt, reject, or modify and adopt the proposed order. All parties of record will be notified, in writing, of the decision.




