Notice is hereby given that the Crook County Court will hold a Public Hearing at **9:00 a.m. November 2 & December 7, 2022**, in the Crook County Meeting Room, 320 NE Court Street, Prineville, Oregon, to consider the following:

Record Number: 217-22-000777-PLNG, a hearing before the Crook County Court to consider the Planning Commission's recommendation to amend the Crook County Comprehensive Plan to add a 98.7-acre portion of property to Crook County's inventory of Significant Mineral and Aggregate Sites ("Aggregate Inventory").
