The County Court convened to hold a public hearing at 1:30 p.m. at the Crook County Annex at 320 NE Court Street, Prineville, Oregon. Present at the meeting were County Commissioner Jerry Brummer, County Commissioner Brian Barney, and County Legal Counsel Jeff Wilson. County Judge Seth Crawford was unavailable. No members of the public were present.

The purpose of the hearing was to consider a land use appeal filed by Chuck Hegele, the applicant and owner of the subject property, regarding Crook County Planning Commission's January 10, 2019 denial of a conditional use permit for a private park (RV Campground in conjunction with Living History Museum).

The Court acknowledged receipt of a request to postpone the public hearing from the applicant, Chuck Hegele, dated Thursday, February 7, 2019, including the applicant's agreement to waive the 150-day time requirement contained in ORS 215.427.

Commissioner Jerry Brummer moved to approve the request to postpone the matter to a date and time certain on Wednesday, March 20, 2019, at 1:30 p.m. Commissioner Brian Barney seconded the motion followed by a unanimous vote in favor of the request. There being no further matters coming before the Court, the Court recessed until 3:30 p.m.
