MINUTES OF THE February 8, 2017
SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CROOK COUNTY COURT

BE IT REMEMBERED THAT the Crook County Court held a special public meeting on Wednesday, February 8, 2017 at approximately 11:00 a.m. in the meeting room, 320 NE Court Street, Prineville, Oregon. No executive session was held.

The purpose of the meeting was to nominate the ten individuals who have applied to fill the vacancy in Commissioner position # 2.

Commissioner Brummer moved to nominate all qualified candidates who had submitted applications for consideration for position # 2. Judge Crawford seconded. Motion passed 2-0.

Each candidate will be interviewed on Friday, February 10, in the order in which they submitted their complete application. The interviews will begin 9:30 a.m. All candidates are asked to wait in the meeting room lobby before their interviews – after their interviews are completed, they are welcome to sit in the meeting room if they choose. This is intended to keep the interview as fair as possible.

Gordon Aggers, local resident, asked whether the interview meeting is open to the public. Judge Crawford answers yes.

The schedule for the interviews is read aloud.

There being no further matter before the Court, the meeting was adjourned at approximately 11:07 a.m.
