The meeting convened at 498 SE Lynn Blvd, Prineville, Oregon. The media was provided notice of the meeting.

Following the initial meeting on June 14th, DLR Group returned today with 4 conceptual drawings including 4 different configurations of a proposed jail and jail support facilities. The goal of today's meeting is to review the component space summary, receiving input on each item to refine the programing needs and return in two weeks with a revised conceptual plan.

The meeting continued for approx. 5 hours including a 1 hour lunch break from approx. 12:30 to 1:30.

During the meeting, comments were received regarding the 4 conceptual drawings, the square footage and space needs for both the jail and support staff with Option (conceptual drawing) #3 identified as the preferred option. The rationale for selecting option 3 was primarily based on staying within the footprint of County owned property (no additional property acquisition required), plus the desire to establish connectivity with the existing Sheriff's office, and the location of the Sally Port away from 2nd street traffic.

A follow-up meeting is scheduled for July 12.

Meeting adjourned approximately 4pm. The County appreciates the hospitality of the Extension Office in making the 4-H building available to us.
