BE IT REMEMBERED THAT the Crook County Court met in a Special Executive County Court Session on November 30, 2015 beginning at 9:00 a.m. in the County meeting room located at 320 NE Court Street, Prineville, Oregon.

In attendance were: County Judge Mike McCabe; County Commissioner Ken Fahlgren; County Commissioner Seth Crawford; County Counsel Jeff Wilson; Assistant County Counsel Eric Blaine and County Court Secretary Colleen Ferguson.

Judge McCabe called the meeting to order. Planning Director Bill Zelenka attended. City Planning Director Phil Stenbeck came in and joined the meeting upon request. There were no other members of the public in the meeting room.

Judge McCabe adjourned the Court out of Open Session and into Executive Session ORS 192.660(2)(e) Real Property, to conduct deliberations with persons designated by the governing body to negotiate real property transactions.
