BE IT REMEMBERED THAT the Crook County Court met in a Special Open Public Session on August 26, 2015 at 4:00 p.m. in the County meeting room located at 320 NE Court Street, Prineville, Oregon. The purpose of the special meeting was to discuss and consider approval of an agreement for Long term Rural Oregon Enterprise Zone Exemption on taxable property and Order 2015-44 regarding Project Vitesse.

County Counsel Jeff Wilson provided a brief Staff Report on the project and Order 2015-44. County Planning Director Bill Zelenka provided a staff report.
