### Continuation for Deliberations

- **Record Number 217-24-000293-PLNG:** Conditional Use – Continuation for Deliberations only.
  - Proposal for a photovoltaic (pv) solar power generation facility located on property zoned Exclusive Farm Use zone, EFU-3. The proposal includes a ground mounted solar array, gen tie transmission lines, a substation, an energy storage system, and an operation and maintenance facility. The project is proposed to be a 320-acre site, on a portion of property identified as map tax lot: 1615000000300. It is north of an existing solar facility.

### Public Hearing

- **Record Number 217-25-000289-PLNG:** Legislative amendment.
  - Legislative amendment to the County's Comprehensive Plan to update the Transportation Systems Plan pursuant to OAR 660-012 and statewide planning goal 12. The TSP is one of the planning requirements for Counties, to plan a safe, convenient, and economical transportation system. This TSP will replace the County's existing TSP. This TSP will plan for the next twenty years of county growth and transportation needs including multimodal travel, necessary connections, and preferred capital improvements.
