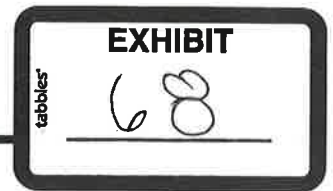

Please allow me to add another comment.

9. There should be a road connecting the "work force" housing and the other housing areas and amenities on the resort. This would allow another exit for all residents during an emergency, and access for those living in the work force area to other housing and amenities without adding traffic to Highway 126 which is overloaded already.

Is the work force intended to house those working on the resort? Or is this simply a lower priced housing (which is needed)? Will there be CCRs for the work force housing similar to the resort? Most importantly, there needs to be a requirement that people cannot dump old cars and trailers and decrepit mobile homes on their property to decay as we see on Stillman Road and Riggs Road.
