Crossing Trails FAQ

Q: When and where will the meeting be occurring?

A: Wednesday, July 27th & Thursday, July 28th, 5:30pm – 8:00pm, Carey Foster Hall @ the Crook County Fairgrounds, 1280 Main, Prineville, OR 97754 – (Fairgrounds entrance) or you may use the entrance on Lynn Blvd.

The public hearing is scheduled for two consecutive days to allow for presentations and oral testimony. The Planning Commission may impose time limits on the presentation of material and oral testimony by other interested parties.

Q: If I submit comments or exhibits before the hearing, will I receive notice of the hearing? How do I get on the notice list?

A: The Crook County code matches Oregon State Statute regarding who receives notice. Property owners within 750 feet of the subject property boundary will receive notice of the initial hearing.

Once your written testimony or oral testimony is received at the Planning Commission Hearing, you become a party of standing and are added to the notification list for a decision on the application, or if required for additional hearings. With written submittals, be sure to include up to date contact information.

Q: How do I submit evidence, testimony, or comments?

A: Evidence, testimony, or comments should be submitted as early as possible, but can be submitted up to and at the hearing.

Information provided earlier gives the Planning Commission time to review all material prior to the meeting and are then able to address those concerns if applicable.

All written or oral submittals will be considered by the Planning Commission.

Phone calls to planning staff will not be made part of the record. You must submit written testimony or make oral testimony at the public hearing.

Submittals should be sent to Plan@co.crook.or.us, or can be dropped off at the Crook County Community Development Department @ 300 NE 3rd Street Room 12, Prineville.

If you plan on utilizing a visual presentation at the hearing, please email or bring the presentation to us as early as possible, to ensure the efficient presentation of the information at the hearing.
