must provide proof of public liability insurance, including property damage, cov	vering all the
Permittee's activities arising out of the work to be performed under a County pe	ermit.

Permittee maintain Commercial General Liability insurance with minimum limits equal to the liability limits as set by the Oregon Revised Statutes for a public entity; (ORS 30.271 & 30.272 et seq.) aggregate and naming Crook County as an additional insured. Permittee must provide County with evidence of insurance.

The policy also shall bear the following endorsement:

"Without prejudice to coverage otherwise existing herein, Crook County and all other governmental bodies having jurisdiction in the area, their officers and employees are included as additional insured under this policy as to any claims or claims for injury to person, including death, or damage to property, resulting from or growing out of the activities of the named insured, including all work to be done under the permit issued by the County."

"It is understood and agreed that this policy shall not terminate or be canceled prior to the completion of the permitted work without first giving 30 days written notice of intention to terminate or to cancel said policy to the County."

"Notwithstanding the naming of additional insured, the said policy shall protect each insured in the same manner as though a separate policy had been issued to each; but nothing herein shall operate to increase the insurer's liability as set forth elsewhere in the policy beyond the amount or amounts for which the insurer would have been liable if only one person or interest had been named as insured."

A certificate evidencing such insurance together with the above endorsement shall be submitted to the County and shall be subject to the approval of County Counsel on behalf of Crook County as to adequacy of protection.

GENERAL PROVISIONS FOR POLELINE, PIPELINE AND BURIED CABLE PERMITS & OPERATIONS WITHIN COUNTY ROW

NORKSITE: 1. Permittee must call for utility locates before digging (1-800-332-2344). You may be held liable for damages. Pre-marking of excavation areas is required. 2. Permittee shall have a copy of this permit and all attachments at the worksite. They shall be available to the Road Master or Designee. 3. Permittee to review Crook County Court 12.08 (such review is acknowledged by signature below). 4. Access control fence must be maintained during construction and restored to its original or better condition after construction is complete. 5. The permittee shall not use the right of way to display advertising signs or merchandise of any kind. 6. The stopping and parking of vehicles upon County Road right of way for the maintenance of adjoining property or in furtherance of any business transaction or commercial establishment is strictly prohibited. 7. All grass/trees and small brush within the work area shall be removed, rotary or flail mowed to ground level prior to the beginning of work to facilitate clean up. O Disturbed areas shall be reseeded with grass native to the area in an appropriate seeding time. A "plant establishment" shall be understood to be part of the planting work to assure satisfactory growth of planted materials. The plant establishment period will begin when the original planting and all landscape construction has been completed and approved. The length of the establishment period will be one calendar year or as defined in the Special Provisions. Noxious weed management shall receive approval from Crook County Weed Master in writing and provided to Road Master. 8. The spreading of mud or debris upon any County Road is strictly prohibited and violation shall be cause for immediate cancellation of the permit. Clean up shall be at the permittee's expense. The County Road shall be cleaned of all dirt and debris at the end of each work day, or more frequently if so determined by the Road Master. 9. 


